

State Community Service Award

All clubs in good standing are eligible to apply for the award. All applications for the Community Service Award must be received for judging postmarked on or before December 31 of each year.

The State Community Service Award shall be presented to the club who, during the calendar year will be awarded by the judging criteria found below:

JUDGING CRITERIA FOR COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

Community Service Accomplishments

Participation in community or other civic affairs, bringing credit to the member club, the Association and the sport of 4-wheeling. Specific accomplishments include, but are not limited to:

1. Participation in disaster relief organizations as a member of the response teams-either during training exercises or an actual emergency (example: earthquake, civil disobedience, forest fire, flood, etc.)
2. Participation in search and rescue operations as a member of the response team-either during training exercises or an actual emergency (example: lost child, weather-bound persons, downed aircraft, etc.).
3. Participation in organized community charitable events (example: March of Dimes walks, rallies, fund-raisers, etc.)
4. Participation in civic events (example: parades, festivals, fairs, etc.).

NOTE: Participation in projects that qualify for the Conservation Awards are specifically prohibited from judging for the State Community Service Award.

All participants must include verification of all projects, events, times and dates for judging (example: newspaper clippings, photos, letters of commendation, etc.)

An essay detailing the clubs community service activities must be submitted to the Sacramento Office by December 31 of the current year.
