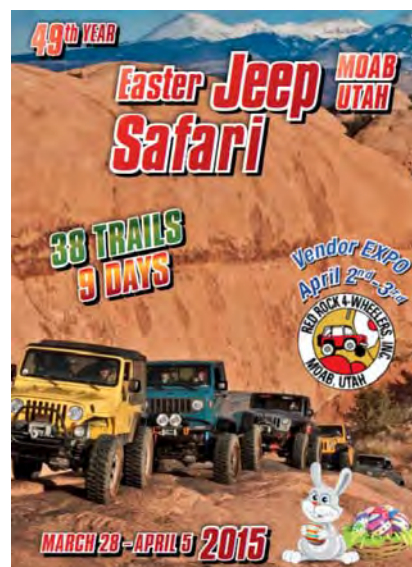

Joey, Myself and Craig Rutherford came in on Thursday to a quiet campground "Smith Forks" and set up, nice weather and fired up the bar b que, had a couple of sodas and retired early for the evening . Friday morning we air down and head out to set up the DDD signs, we make are way out to the frontage road and head into Frasier Park for gas. From there we head towards the trailhead to get our bearings, it's been awhile 4 or 5 years since we had been there, the last time I took my Gray jeep (cj7) and it did not run well in the altitude and heat, vapor locking in a precarious position but, that problem is fixed and now it is somebody else's problem. Moving forward we decided to take another trail #118 that is only about an hour long and dropped us back into Lockwood Valley as we finished the trail it took us to a parking lot for hikers and came across some expensive Photo equipment and no one around, shortly after that the owner came back to re-claim his gear and we had a laugh with him and Joey gave him a couple of waters, and we moved on.

Now were on our way to the North entrance to Hungry Valley Park to do some more jeeping, we enter at Gold Hill RD. and make are way to Red Tail Cyn from there we get on to a trail that is called Vics Cat Trail this is suppose to be a Black Diamond trail and it was up and down a steep switch back and it was a great trail, from there we end up in a wash trail which was the West Freeman Trail and toured that for a while it was scenic but little jeeping the a Right turn onto another Black Diamond trail? called Homestead Trail and it was up and down a small switch back trail and then on to camp where more people were showing up for the Friday afternoon we had a few more jeepers showing up, and then I am getting text and phone calls which had very little cell service about a fire that started in Cajon Pass, burning cars and moving fast and your being evacuated, are you O.K. ?I appreciate the concerns but, not much I can do, we were already gone and let the fire dept. do their thing, by Saturday not one call or text so all is well. Read on to Saturday report by Joe Brutha (sista), it was a great time with some really neat weather.

Saturday Report

I woke up Saturday morning to a partly cloudy sky. This was due to the remnants of tropical storm "Delores" out of Mexico. The cooler temperatures felt great as the day before was up in the 90's. We got out of camp about 9:00 am with 7 jeeps. We were off to the Flying J in Frazier park to top off. After we topped off we headed down the pavement to the Lockwood Valley Road turn off. Jimmy stopped here to make sure that there were still 7 jeeps. Well, it seemed that Vince continued west on the paved road and kept going (I think his mom lives that way). We waited about 20 minutes before Jimmy went to find Vince. Mark Bargman eventually got Vince on the cell phone and told him to turn around as he had missed the turn off. Once we were back together we headed south about 5 miles to the trail head. At this stop we aired down. While airing down we had a nice capable 4 door Rubicon JK pull up from behind. They asked if they could follow. In the Rubicon were Jeb and his son Nathan. They eventually caught up with us later on the trail as we were about finished airing down when they had pulled up to air down.

The jeepin started right when we crossed the creek and it was a steep climb to the top of the ridge. By this time the sky was getting darker and there was only about 5% fair sky showing. All of us were wondering what the weather might be like at the top of Alamo Mountain where the trail peaks at about 6700'. Actually, the cloud cover was a big help in keeping a lid on the heat. We continued on the trail and then it began to sprinkle and both I and the Phelps did not have tops! It only sprinkled a little, so the moisture was much a welcome for dust control. The trail did not let us down. There were good climbs and the scenery and views were great. We did stop for lunch at our traditional spot for lunch as there was a picnic table and big shade trees.

After lunch we crossed the creek and began the steep climb up towards Alamo Mountain. According to Jimmy, the trail would climb up over 2000' from the creek to the top of the trail. This is the roughest part of the trail as it is very steep and rocky. There are many switch backs and steep inclines. Near the top of the trail, Mark Phelps drove to the right when he should have gone to the left only to get high centered on a large rock shelf. This was a tricky spot in which you did not notice the drop off on the other side until you were in it. Vince gave Mark a tug off of the rock and we continued. Once on top of Alamo we stopped to regroup. After the social top, we then headed down the dirt road to connect back up with the Gold Mountain paved road which put us right back to the Smith Forks Campground.

We arrived back in camp at about 3:30 pm. I decided to throw a tarp on the jeep as it was beginning to sprinkle. I was glad I did as the rain really began to come down. I headed over to Jimmy's motor home where he was putting together jalapeno poppers. Jimmy took the poppers outside to put them on his BBQ. It seems that Jimmy's shade structure had a leak in the corrugated metal and the water was leaking on to Jimmy and his BBQ. Does anyone know of a good roofer? By this time, the rain was coming down pretty hard. There was thunder and lightning strikes and also new river was forming thru the middle of camp separating David Meyer and Mark Phelps camps from the rest of the camp. By this time happy hour was under full swing and then decided to move over to Vince's place. While we were in Vince's motor home we noticed that the roof vent open and water was pouring in. It was amazing how much water was dripping from the vent and on to the floor. It became amusing when Vince would grab a paper towel to wipe the water off the floor only to have it drip more when he was either turned around or when he was not looking. I also want to thank Jeannie Bargman for cooking up stir-

fry and bringing it over to us. I left Vince's at around 10:00 pm.

On Sunday morning the sky was again partly cloudy but rain was in the forecast for later. I left camp at around 9:00 am and took the main paved road thru Hungry Valley and on to Frazier Park to gas up for the trip home. I had a good jump on traffic until I was nearing the Smokey Bear turn off and realized that the DDD signs had not been picked up! The only call that went through my cell phone was to David Meyer and he was already at Frazier Park. So, I got back on the dirt road and picked up the signs that we had put out. It was about a 45 minute delay. Thank you for to those that participated.

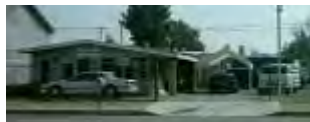
