Conservation report - none given, Don Rybarczyk was not present.

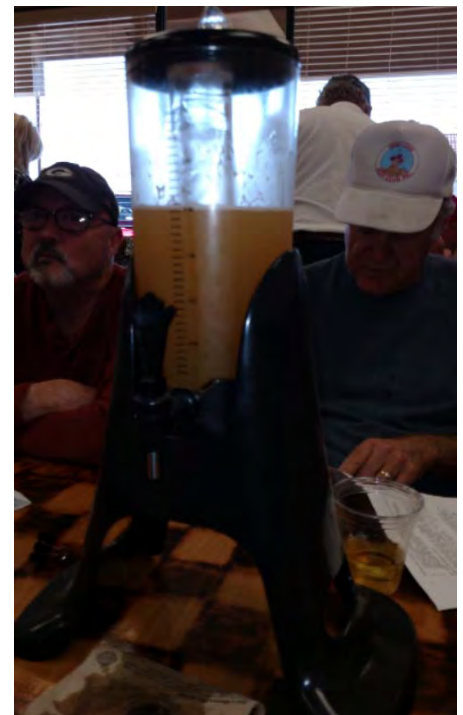
Delegate's report - none given, Joey Morrison was not present. Nothing to report, the next meeting is October 24th.

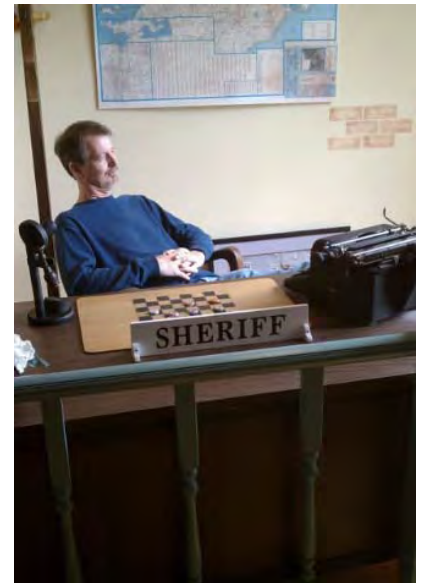

Trail Bosses Responsibility

- Plan and organize all aspects of the trip
- Create and forward materials such as maps, adventure pass, if needed, date and time, trail expectations and camping needs to newsletter editor. This should be done 60-90 days prior to jeep run
- If unable to forward to newsletter editor it is the trail bosses responsibility to get all information to all members and qualifying members.
- Trail bosses should have a backup plan in case primary plan has complications or closures.
- All trail bosses should help organize camping spaces with regards to forming a circle to ensure a common fire area.
- It is recommended that trail bosses conduct a drivers meeting the morning of the run. If no drivers meeting you must advise everyone when run will leave camp.
- Trail bosses need to place DDD signs to help participants locate camp.
- If trail bosses wish the “Drifters Jeep Club” banner, it can be put up.
- It is the responsibility of previous trail bosses to get DDD signs and banner to the next trail bosses.
- During the run, trail bosses must keep the run organized by having a leader and a tail gunner. At no time should a trail boss leave anyone behind.
- Please advise all in attendance that we will be on CB radio channel 15 or club radio channel 1 or both.
- The trail bosses must get trip report to newsletter editor no later than the 12th of the month following the run.
- The trail bosses should get attendance to the Vice President as soon as possible. Please do not make the Vice President get the info from the newsletter. A form is being provided to ease the process of attendance.
- A “Boner” flag should be given out at the meeting following the run. Remember, the “Boner” flag is a good natured way to tell your jeepn buddy “OK, so you had a problem, we have all been there”. The Boner flag is not an insult and nobody should take it that way.

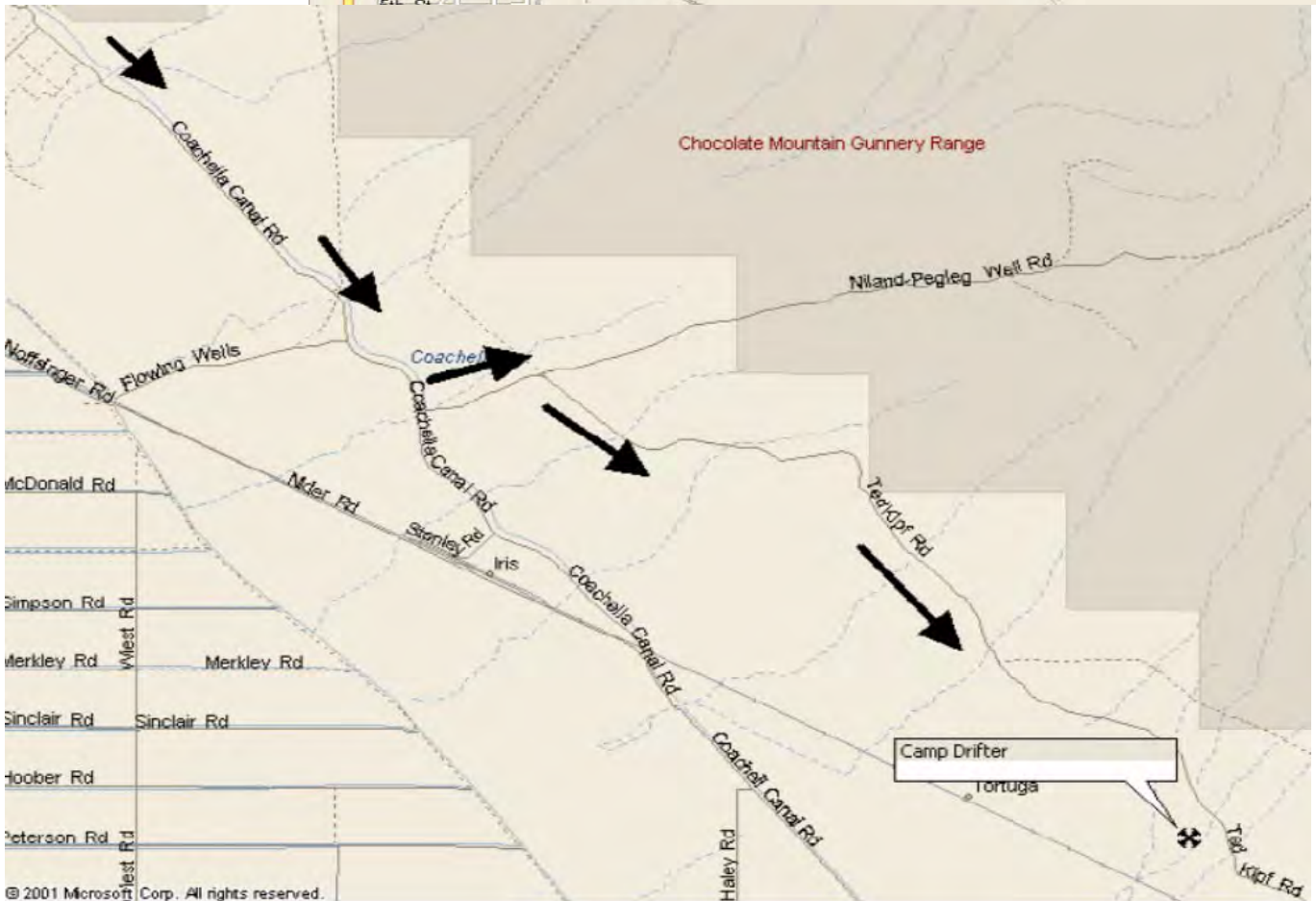

DDD Club Radio Frequencies

Drifter "Club Radio" is a modified 2 Meter Ham Radio. The 2M radio operates in 144-148 MHz frequency, but can receive the frequencies below. However, to transmit in the DDD frequencies, you need to modify the radio. Search the internet for modification instructions to your specific radio. Ham radio's, antenna and accessories can be purchased from Amateur Electronic Supply

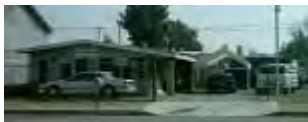
