Meeting adjourned at 7:40 p.m.

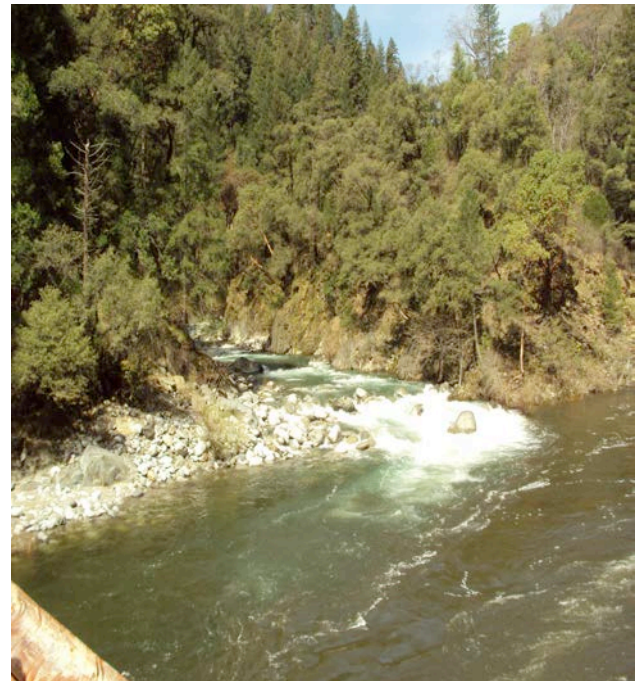
